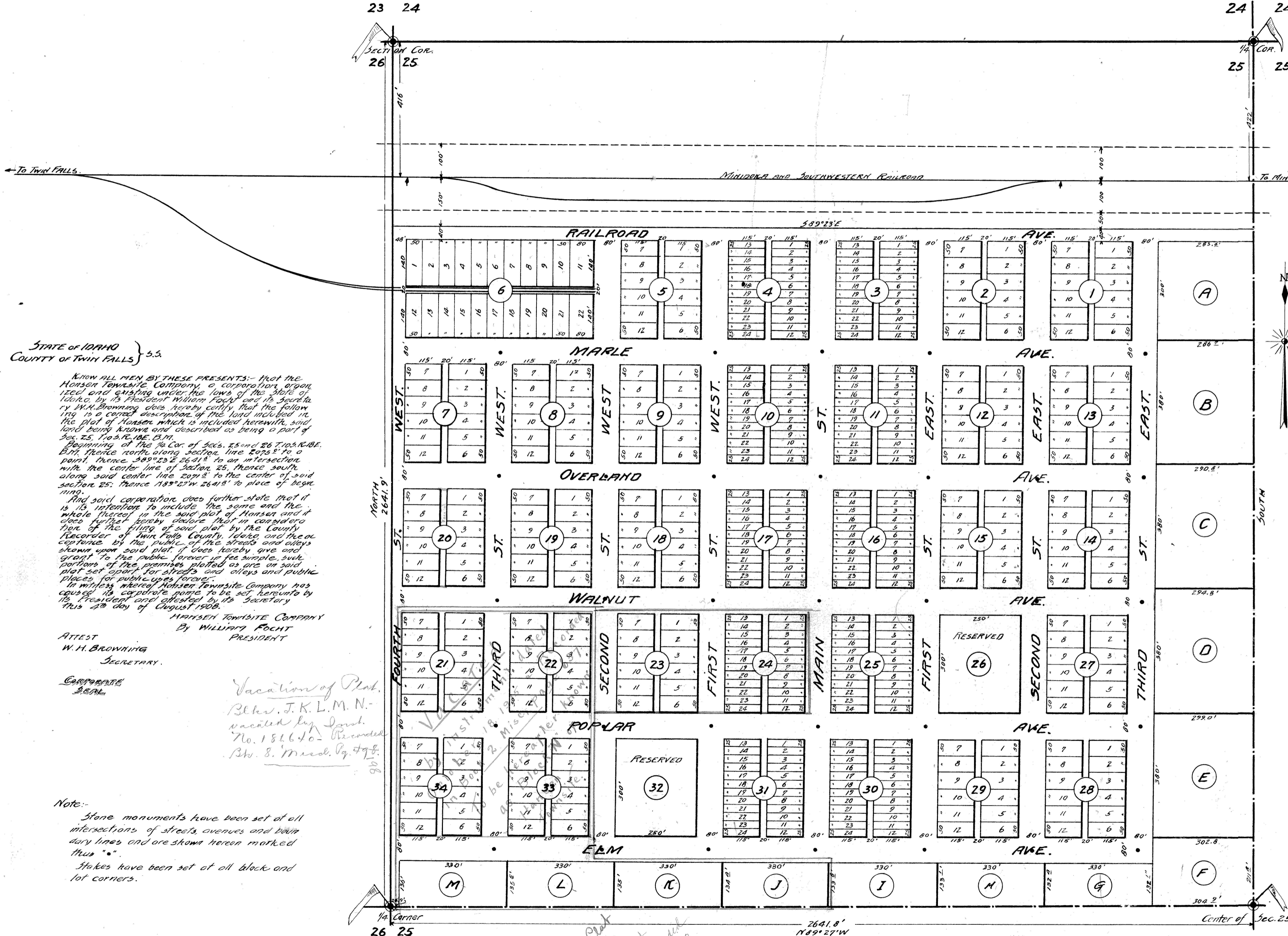


**PLAT**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That the Hansen Townsite Company, a corporation, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Idaho, by its President William Focht and its Secretary W.H. Browning, does hereby certify that the following is a correct description of the land included in the plat of Hansen which is included herewith, said land being known and described as being a part of Sec. 25, T10S. R18E. B.M.

Beginning at the 1/4 Cor. of Secs. 25 and 26 T10S. R18E. B.M. thence north along section line 2075' to a point, thence 389°23'E 2641.8' to an intersection with the center line of section 25, thence south along said center line 2071.8' to the center of said section 25; thence 183°27'W 2641.8' to place of beginning.

And said corporation does further state that it is its intention to include the same and the whole thereof in the said plat of Hansen and it does further hereby declare that in consideration of the filing of said plat by the County Recorder of Twin Falls County, Idaho, and the acceptance by the public of the streets and alleys shown upon said plat, it does hereby give and grant to the public forever in fee simple, suit portions of the premises platted as are on said plat set apart for streets and alleys and public places for public uses forever.
